Le Rocher du Secret – Île du Levant, France

The views are golden here, and we aren't just talking about the nude bodies. Romance radiates off this <u>couples-only</u>, <u>16-suite French Riviera naturist holiday gem</u>, located in the naturist district of Heliopolis. Here, you can go nude in private or join other like-minded naturists at the pool, solarium or hot tub. Gaze out over the Mediterranean from the garden terrace with a cocktail, then savour the fish specialties at one of the nine local restaurants.
